The three seasons you can enter and their prizes are:

1. Early/Late Archery Season Big Buck wins \$250.00 Cash

- - Buck taken in early or late archery season that weighs the most.
- - Must register and pay entry fee before harvesting a buck to be entered into the contest.

2. Muzzleloading Season Big Buck wins \$250.00 Cash

- - Buck taken in the muzzle-loading season that weighs the most.
- - Must register and pay entry fee before harvesting a buck to be entered into the contest.

3. Regular Firearm Season Big Buck wins \$250.00 Cash

- - Buck taken in the firearm season that weighs the most.
- - Must register and pay entry fee before harvesting a buck to be entered into the contest.

That's not all! You are also eligible for the following additional prizes:

\$250.00 Cash - The Trudeau Big Buck

- - The ONE buck, from any season, that weighs the most.
- - You also get an individual plaque and your name is engraved on the club house located permanent Trudeau Big Buck Club plaque.

\$250.00 Cash - Lucky Registration

- - You do not have to get a buck, just enter the contest. Every entry gets a chance for this "Lucky Registration" raffle.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1) Entry into each season category is \$25.00. Each entry receives one Lucky Buck raffle entry.
- 2) Registration and entry into any season category must be made/dated before harvesting a buck to be entered into the contest.
- 3) Bucks must be taken in the Northern Zone of New York State.
- 4) The person harvesting the buck must be the one entering the buck into the contest and be present at the weigh in.
- 5) All bucks entered must be fully cleaned before being weighed (no internal organs).
- 6) All weigh-ins will be at Woods and Waters, 255 Broadway, Saranac Lake, NY 12983, 518-891-1110, during their posted working hours. The weigh-in slip must be initialed by the person weighing the deer. Proof of location where harvested will be required (DEC Wildlife Management Area). Weighing official will inspect all entries. You will have five (5) days after each season closes to weigh-in your buck (this allows time for you to return from camp).
- 7) All bucks will be judged by dressed hanging weight. In the case of a tie, the winner will be determined by the number of points on the rack, if a tie still exists it will be determined by the first buck entered.
- 8) All bucks entered must be harvested in compliance of all rules and regulations of NYS-DEC. You may only enter deer personally harvested.
- 9) Judges decision is final. Any questions call Woods and Waters @ (518) 891-1110
